In Isaiah 55:8 God declares "For My thoughts are not your thoughts, nor are your ways My ways." That prominent difference means that there will be times that we don't understand what God is doing. In those times God calls us to yield to His will and His way. There are important lessons to learn about yielding in the book of Jonah.

**2. When you yield you serve**

(Jonah 3:1-10)

- a) It is important to serve according to the word of the Lord (vs. 1-10)
- b) A yielded life is willing to make a sacrifice (vs. 4)

*A yielded life responds with obedience to God's word.*

**3. When you yield you learn**

(Jonah 4:1-11)

- a) We have to be honest about what is in our heart (vs. 1-3)
- b) The heart of God is revealed to a yielded life (vs. 4-11)

*A yielded life grows from new understanding.*
