Mark 7:5-8, 21-23

- a) Worship is honoring God with your lips and your heart (vs. 6, 21-23)
- b) Worship is teaching and holding the commandment of God (vs. 7-8)
  - Your words, heart and lifestyle create your worship.

### 2. **Worship includes service**

Luke 4:5-8

- a) Your worship and service should be given to God and not to the world (vs. 5-8)
  - What you serve defines your worship.

### 3. **Worship must be done in spirit and truth**

John 4:19-24

- a) You are to worship the Father (vs. 23)
- b) Worship involves who you are and what you love (vs. 24)

### 4. **God desires collective worship**

Hebrews 10:19-25

- a) We have one great priest over the house of God (vs. 21)
- b) We are told to assemble together to stimulate and encourage love and good deeds (vs. 24-25)
  - Worshiping together magnifies worship (Ps. 34:3).

### 5. **God calls for living worship**

Romans 11:36 - 12:2

- a) Surrendering your life is your spiritual service of worship (12:1)
- b) Letting God transform you is your spiritual service of worship (vs. 12:2)
  - Worship is a lifestyle and not just an action.
