**2. You are called to minister in Christ's Church**

(Ephesians 4:11-16)

- a) We are being equipped for the work of service and the building up of the body of Christ (vs. 12)
- b) The proper working of each individual part of Christ's body causes the growth of the body for the building up of itself in love (vs. 16)

*God's fellowship calls us to ministry for Christ.*

**3. You are called to walk in the light of God**

(1 John 1:5-7)

- a) Fellowship with God is affected by our walk (vs. 6)
- b) Fellowship with one another is affected by our walk (vs. 7)
