Matthew 21:1-17

In the Palm Sunday story of Jesus entering Jerusalem, we see people responding to Jesus. Because some respond well and some do not, it is important to ask ourselves "why?" As Matthew tells the story, we see that the attitudes of the people make the difference. We can learn to better honor Jesus the King by understanding the Palm Sunday Attitudes.

- c) The right attitude promotes complete obedience (vs. 6-7)
  - I choose to give my life, possessions and service to Jesus.

### 2. The attitude of blessing

Matthew 21:8-11

- a) A demonstration of praise is appropriate for servants (vs. 8)
- b) A demonstration of praise is appropriate for those who have been saved (vs. 9)
- c) A demonstration of praise is appropriate for those who know Jesus (vs. 10-11)
  - I choose to demonstrate my exalted view of Jesus every day.

### 3. The attitude of grieving

Matthew 21:12-17

- a) Jesus recognized that prayer had lost value in the house of God (vs. 12-13)
- b) Jesus recognized that the work of God had lost value in the eyes of the religious leaders (vs. 14-17)
  - I will allow Jesus to restore the things of God that are missing in my life.
