**2. He is not a man-made king**

(Matthew 26:63-66)

- a) Jesus is the Christ, the Messiah, the rightful king of all men and all things (vs. 63-64)
- b) Jesus is the Son of God (vs. 63)
- c) Jesus' testimony was considered blasphemy by the high priest (vs. 65-66)

Jesus the king possesses the right to rule my life.

**3. He is not a king of this world**

(Matthew 27:11)

- a) Jesus is the king of the Jews (Matthew 27:11)
- b) Jesus' kingdom is not of this world (John 18:36)
- c) Jesus is Lord and King of the Kingdom of Heaven (Matthew 7:21)
- d) The word of God is the word of the kingdom (Matthew 13:19) (Luke 8:11)

*Jesus the king calls for me to serve the Father's will.*
