1. The stone had been removed

(Luke 24:1-3)

- a) The women came to the tomb at early dawn (vs. 1) (23:55-56)
- b) The stone was rolled away from the tomb (vs. 2)
- c) The body of Jesus could not be found (vs. 3)

Jesus was gone from the tomb.

2. The angels had a message

(Luke 24:4-6)

- a) The angels were dazzling and terrifying (vs. 4-5)
- b) The angels described Jesus as living, not dead (vs. 5)
- c) The angels said Jesus had risen (vs. 6)

Jesus was alive; He had risen from the dead.

3. Jesus spoke of this event

(Luke 24:6-11)

- a) Jesus said that He would be delivered into the hands of sinful men (vs. 7)
- b) Jesus said that He would be crucified (vs. 7)
- c) Jesus said that on the third day He would rise again (vs. 7)

Jesus foretold His death, burial and resurrection.
