(Romans 7:1-6)

- a) The Law is for those who have life (vs. 1-3)
- b) Christians die to the Law through the body of Christ (vs. 4-5)
- c) We have been released from the Law so that we serve in newness of the Spirit (vs. 6)

*Christians are free from the requirements of the Law.*

**2. The truth about the Law**

(Romans 7:7-13)

- a) The Law is not sin (vs. 7-8)
- b) The Law is not a cause of death (vs. 9-13)
- c) The Law is holy and the commandment is righteous and good (vs. 12)

*The Law is beneficial in teaching what is good and right.*

**3. The conflict between two laws**

(Romans 7:14-25)

- a) The Law is spiritual and we are flesh, sold into bondage to sin (vs. 14)
- b) We don't practice what we would like to do and are doing the very thing we hate (vs. 15-16)
- c) The Law of God (in our mind) is set against the law of sin (in our members) (vs. 17-23)
- d) We need to be set free! We serve God with our mind and we serve sin with our flesh (vs. 24-25)

*Jesus gives us freedom over our conflict with the two laws.*
