- d) Each one of us shall give account of himself to God (vs. 10-12)

**2. Do not hinder one another**

(Romans 14:13-23)

- a) Don't put an obstacle or a stumbling block in a brother's way (vs. 13)
- b) Choose to walk according to love, not hurt and destruction (vs. 14-15)

- c) Do not let what is a good thing for you be spoken of as evil (vs. 16)
- d) The kingdom of God is righteousness, peace and joy in the Holy Spirit (vs. 17-18)
- e) Pursue the things which make for peace and the building up of one another (vs. 19-21)
- f) The faith that you have, have as your own conviction before God (vs. 22-23)
