- b) I am supposed to edify others for their good  
(vs. 2-4)
- c) God will give me the perseverance and encouragement to accomplish this important ministry (vs. 5-6)

**2. Accept one another**

(Romans 15:7-13)

- a) Christ accepted you to the glory of God  
(vs. 7)
- b) Christ represents acceptance from the truth of God and the mercy of God (vs. 8-12)

- c) Acceptance provides us with hope, joy and peace (vs. 13)

**3. Be a minister of Christ**

(Romans 15:14-33)

- a) I must use goodness and knowledge to admonish others (vs. 14)
- b) I must be a priestly minister of the gospel of God (vs. 15-16)

*The ministry of Christ is empowered by the Holy Spirit.*
